Call for proposals

The 14th International Conference on Software, Telecommunications and Computer Networks (SoftCOM 2006), co-sponsored by the IEEE Communication Society (ComSoc), will be held aboard the cruising ship "Marko Polo", September 29 - October 1, visiting Split and Dubrovnik. The participants will have an opportunity to cruise along the Croatian Adriatic coast, the very first choice for the top 10 Adventure 2006, by National Geographic.

SoftCOM 2006 will provide an open forum for communications technology researchers and engineers to discuss new and emerging systems, standards and services, and their applications in telecommunications and information systems. The Conference will feature symposia, general and special sessions, tutorials, workshops and business forum.

Prototype presentations will gather experts and professionals who wish to demonstrate new systems, applications and services, and to share opinions and experiences regarding performances, functionality, technological and marketing aspects of ICT products.
